Notes:

1. Minimum credit required to graduate: 36 credits.
2. Required coursses: 6 credits; elective courses: 30 credits. (If there are different teaching divisions, please list the required graduation credits for each teaching division under the

"Departmental requirements" section.)

3. Credits earned by students from the common courses offered by their respective colleges shall be accepted as their affiliated department's professional courses. However, credits earned from interdisciplinary courses offered either by their college or by other colleges will be accepted as credits earned from departments outside their own.
4. Departmental requirements (Ex: programs, certifications, licenses, recognition of external department credits, prerequisite requirements, Credits needed for each teaching division, and other requirements):
 - A. A maximum of 6 credits from recognized courses in other departments will be accepted.
 - B. Prior to applying for the degree examination, students are required to participate in at least one relevant academic seminar or conference, either within or outside the university, and must submit supporting documentation. Participation in interim presentations organized by the department shall not be counted for this requirement. Moreover, no later than the semester preceding the application for the degree examination, students must either present their thesis at the department's graduate thesis interim presentation or at an external academic conference with the prior approval of their thesis advisor.
