 - (1) 本系四技必修 40 學分,選修 60 學分,其選修學分包含:專業選修課程至少 48 學分、外語學院學程必選 12 學分、承認外系課程至多 12 學分。
 - (2) 畢業前取得相當 1. N1 日語檢定考試 2. 通譯士考試 3. 導遊考試 4. TOPJ 上級考試 5. 其他符合系上規定之任一考試的測驗合格證書者,始得准予畢業。入學前已取得者須提出證明文件。未通過以上測驗者,應修習「綜合日語進階」,且成績須合格,始得准予畢業。相關規定請見本系「日語能力檢定畢業門檻實施作業要點」。
 - (3)入學前日語能力已達畢業門檻之四技學生可申請免修必修課程之初階日語Ⅰ及初階日語Ⅱ,共4學分,但仍須以應日系選修學分補足 必修學分數。
 - (4) 須於畢業前至少修畢1門實務專題或1門實習課程。
 - (5) 承認外系課程 12 學分。

- 1. Minimum credits required to graduate: 128 credits.
- 2. Required courses: 40 credits; elective courses: 60 credits (excluding credits earned from university-wide common core requirements and general education courses; if there are different teaching divisions, please list the minimum credits required to graduate for each teaching division under the "Departmental requirements" section.)
- 3. University-wide common core requirements and general education courses total 28 credits. The relevant regulations are based on the school's "Implementation Regulations of Courses in the College of General Education", "Course Schedule of College of the General Education," and "Implementation Regulations of Language Education".
- 4. 8 credits in English and/or a second foreign language are required to graduate.
 - A. The English proficiency graduation requirement for domestic students is CEFR B1 level or higher with related grade report or transcript. For departments with higher English proficiency requirements, the requirements will be in effect.
 - B. Students who fail to meet the graduation requirement after two attempts at English proficiency tests during their academic years may fulfill it by passing any of the following:

 a) School's English proficiency graduation test,
 - b) Participation in a short-term English improvement course offered by the Foreign Language Education Center and compliance with the course regulations,
 - c) Taking and passing at least one professional course that adopts English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI) offered by the college or the department which is worth two or more credits.
 - C. Students with a TOEIC score of 550 or above (equivalent to CEFR B1 level) are exempt from Practical English (1) and (2) (4 credits); those achieving a TOEIC score of 785 or above (equivalent to CEFR B2 level) are exempt from Practical English (1), (2), (3) and (4) (8 credits), but must take elective courses like English for Specific Purposes (ESP) courses or other foreign languages to meet the English and/or second foreign language graduation credit requirements. For courses of other foreign languages, please refer to the course schedule of the Foreign Language Education Center.
- 5. Credits earned by students from the common courses offered by their respective colleges shall be accepted as their affiliated departments' professional courses. However, credits

- earned from interdisciplinary courses offered either by their colleges or by other colleges will be accepted as credits earned from departments outside their own.
- 6. College requirements: Students must complete courses from one of the three major programs offered by the College of Foreign Languages and earn at least 12 credits to obtain the program certificate and meet graduation requirements. The actual courses offered will be primarily based on those provided by the Foreign Languages College.
- 7. Conditions set by the department (program, assessment, certification, recognition of credits from other departments, course exemption regulations, required credits for graduation in each teaching group, and others):
 - A. Students in the four-year technical program must complete 40 credits of required courses and 60 credits of elective courses. The elective credits include at least 48 credits of professional elective courses, 12 credits from mandatory courses in the College of Foreign Languages, and a maximum of 12 credits from recognized courses from other departments.
 - B. To be eligible for graduation, students must obtain a passing certificate from one of the following exams before graduation: 1. JLPT N1, 2. Translator Certification Exam, 3. Tour Guide Exam, 4. TOPJ Advanced Exam, 5. Any other exam that meets departmental requirements. Students who have obtained these certifications prior to enrollment must provide documentation. Those who do not pass the above exams must take the "Total Japanese Intention" course and achieve a passing grade to qualify for graduation. For more details, please refer to the department's "Implementation Guidelines for Japanese Language Proficiency Graduation Requirements."
 - C. Students in the four-year technical program who meet the graduation language proficiency requirement before enrollment may apply for exemption from the required courses Elementary Japanese I and Elementary Japanese II (4 credits total), but must still fulfill the required credits with elective courses in the Japanese department.
 - D. Students must complete at least one Special Projects course or one Internship course before graduation.
 - E. A maximum of 12 credits from recognized courses in other departments will be accepted.

- 5. Credits earned by students from the common courses offered by their respective colleges shall be accepted as their affiliated departments' professional courses. However, credits earned from interdisciplinary courses offered either by their colleges or by other colleges will be accepted as credits earned from departments outside their own.
- 6. College requirements: Students must complete courses from one of the three major programs offered by the College of Foreign Languages and earn at least 12 credits to obtain the

- program certificate and meet graduation requirements. The actual courses offered will be primarily based on those provided by the Foreign Languages College.
- 7. Department Requirements (Programs, Certification Exams, Licenses, Recognition of Credits from Other Departments, Course Restrictions, Required Credits for Each Group, and Others):
 - (1) Students in the two-year technical program are required to complete 12 compulsory credits and 52 elective credits. The elective credits must include at least 40 credits from professional elective courses, 12 credits from the Foreign Language College programs, and up to 12 credits from other departments.
 - (2) Before graduation, students must obtain certification in one of the following tests: 1. N1 Japanese Language Proficiency Test, 2. Interpreter Examination, 3. Tour Guide Examination,
 - 4. TOPJ Advanced Test, or 5. Any other exam approved by the department. Those who have already obtained certification before admission must submit proof. Students who do not pass any of the above tests must take the "Advanced Integrated Japanese" course and pass it to graduate. For more details, please refer to the department's "Japanese Proficiency Test Graduation Requirement Implementation Guidelines.
 - (3) Students must complete at least one practical project or one internship course before graduation.
 - (4) Up to 12 credits from other departments can be recognized.
