However, credits earned from interdisciplinary courses offered either by their college or by other colleges will be accepted as credits earned from departments outside their own.
4. Departmental requirements (Ex: programs, certifications, licenses, recognition of external department credits, and other requirements):
  - A. A maximum of 6 credits from recognized courses in other departments will be accepted.
